Sign-up into VoiceBoxer

To participate to a VoiceBoxer event you must create a user on VoiceBoxer. Don't worry, it only takes a few seconds!

To do so, click on this link https://portal.voiceboxer.com/account/signup and insert your name, email address and a password of your choice. Once you are signed-up you can join any event on VoiceBoxer with your email address and your password.

Moderator / Presenter	Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox	Required	
Attendee	Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer 10+	Not required	Flash plug-in installed if using Safari or Internet Explorer
